Solar Financing: Cash vs. Loan vs. Lease

Cash purchases deliver the fastest ROI (5-7 years), but solar loans (avg. 3.99% APR) let homeowners claim tax credits. Leases require \$0 down but offer lower lifetime savings. For most Floridians, loans strike the ideal balance between affordability and ownership benefits.
